The Lake County Registrar of Voters office encourages Lake County schools to participate in the 2023 High School Voter Education Weeks April 17-28. The purpose of High School Education Weeks is to bring awareness to our young and future voters and set them on the pathway for continued civic engagement.

Eligible students ages sixteen and seventeen can be civically engaged by pre-registering to vote. If students pre-register to vote, they will automatically become voters when they turn eighteen.

Eligible students can register to vote online at <https://registertovote.ca.gov/> or at the Lake County Registrar of Voters office at 325 N Forbes St Lakeport, CA 95453. Registrations are also available at all Lake County Libraries. Staff will set up a booth on scheduled days at the libraries as follows;

Clearlake Library from 2-4pm on Wednesday April 19th

Lakeport Library from 2-4pm on Thursday April 20th

Middletown Library from 2-4pm on Wednesday April 26th

Upper Lake Library from 2-4pm on Thursday April 27th

By working together, we can educate and encourage our young citizens to register to vote and ensure their voices are heard when they are eligible to vote.
